Year 8 History Trip to Worthing Museum-7th March 2023

We are delighted to be able to offer our Year 8 students a trip to Worthing Museum for a morning of History exploration.

The trip is to take place on 7th March 2023 and the contribution for the trip is £6.50.

We will be leaving school at 8.45 am and plan to arrive back at Angmering School at around 1.30 pm.

Students may wear their normal everyday clothes, with appropriate footwear as we will be walking to Angmering station and then from Worthing Station to the museum. Students will also need to bring a coat.

Although students will have lunch when they return to school, they may bring a snack with them and a small amount of money for the gift shop, if they wish.

The price of the trip includes return travel by train and entry to the museum and a workshop run by museum staff.

- At the museum students will be able to visit the galleries showcasing artefacts from Worthing's industrial, victorian and wartime history. This links to their study of Britian during the industrial revolution, WW1 and WW2. We have arranged to have a private viewing of the museum gallerie, which will be closed to the public during our visit.
- They will have a 1 hour workshop with museum staff exploring the history of some of the artefacts and how these link to the history they have been learning in class.

We have 26 places available on the trip. If there is a train strike on the day of the trip, it will be rearranged to another date.

If the trip is over subscribed, places will be allocated by ballot. You will be advised shortly after the 30 January, if your child has a place and details will be put onto Parent Pay. Payment must be made by Friday 24 February 2023.





Please do not try to pay until you have confirmation that your child has a place on the trip. A waiting list will be kept for students who do not gain a place.

Covid guidance:

Should there be changes in government guidelines which results in a trip having to be cancelled as has happened previously during the pandemic, we are no longer able to claim on WSCC insurance for any loss. For this reason we are now only booking trips where the company providing the trip offers a robust cancellation/refund system in respect of Covid cancellations.

At the time of writing there are currently no Government Covid restrictions that may apply to this trip. However, as the Covid 19 situation may change, we will have to follow the Government guidance in place at the time of the trip. This may also include specific requirements that Worthing Museum has at that time.

Therefore it is necessary to point out that should your child be unwell at the time of the trip or is unable to take part in the trip due to Covid 19 restrictions that affects them, then unless we are able to find a student to take your child's place, you will not receive a refund for the place you have booked.

We must tell you that, as the school could not bear any of the costs of the trip without reducing its ability to provide the books and materials that are essential for its curricular needs, the trip cannot take place unless all parents who are able to are willing to contribute. If you would like your son/daughter to participate, but are unable to contribute the full amount, please contact me in confidence, in writing, by 26 January 2023.
