Miss Thompson (SENDCO)

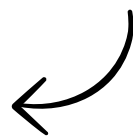
Main role: Mrs Gatford co-ordinates the SEND provision in school and along with a team of excellent teachers and support staff, ensures that support is provided where appropriate. She works most closely with students who have EHCPs and also with those whose needs are presenting as beyond the level of 'school support.'

Miss Webb (Teacher in Charge of the SSC)

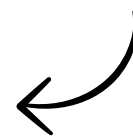
Main role: Miss Webb coordinates support for all students with an EHCP with a physical disability or sensory impairment. She coordinates LSA support and specialist therapy provision and is part of a team alongside Miss Spencer (QToD) and Mr McNamara (QTVI).

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Online Learning



Over the past few years, students have been adapting and changing their learning patterns with many more resources now being based online.

At The Angmering School, we were already using a google based email system and google classroom for our students but the use of this has developed over the years. We have now moved many home learning activities online as we feel that this is a positive way to support students.

All logins will be handed out during the first week of school, please keep these details safe and if you do ever forget them please see Miss Pegden.

It is very important to us that all students are able to access IT equipment when at home. If your child does not have access to a computer or tablet which would allow them to access the google suite easily, please get in touch with Miss Pegden, Year 7 team leader, who can discuss ways in which we can support you further.

The information below gives an overview of the two key online learning resources that we use: classcharts and google classroom.

Classcharts

Website - www.classcharts.com

App available - student version and parent version on android and ios

Purpose - All student homework, positive rewards (credits) and sanctions (debits) are logged on classcharts. As a student or parent, you can see when homework has been set and when it due to be handed in. All homework will be logged on classcharts, even if this is then used as a signpost to other websites.

How to log in - Students will get their login code from their tutor.

Parents will be sent their login code via email.



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Google Classroom

Website - classroom.google.com

App available - on android and ios

Purpose - In many subjects, homework is now uploaded and handed in through google classroom. This enables teachers to upload resources and for students to have online worksheets and quizzes that are submitted directly to the teacher in google doc format allowing for completion on a range of devices. The dashboard

gives an overview of the work requiring completion. It is also being used to upload lesson materials.

How to log in - Students will need to use their Angmering School google login which is the same for their email and google drive. This will be given to students directly.



Lockers

All Year 7 students will be issued a locker on the first day of Year 7. Students need to bring a padlock with them either key or combination lock. You will need a padlock which for security reasons must have a shackle diameter of 7mm (min) and 9mm (max). Body width should be approximately 40mm. Overall height of the padlock should be no more than 70mm. This is essential to fit our lockers. Only Year 7 and 8 are allowed lockers due to a limit on space.
