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### **Year 11 Mock Exam Reminders**

### **Essential Exam Equipment**

To avoid any last-minute issues, please make sure you have:

- More than one black pen (in case one runs out)
- Pencil, eraser, and sharpener
- 30 cm ruler
- Scientific calculator (for calculator-allowed papers)
- Protractor and compasses
- A clear, unlabelled water bottle (as we aren't able to provide water)
- A clear pencil case for their equipment
- Your exam card



#### **Important Exam Rules**

The exam boards take these rules very seriously, and being disqualified from one exam may result in disqualification from all exams. We certainly don't want all your hard work sabotaged by silly and unnecessary mistakes.

- Possession of Unauthorised Materials: Students must not have any unauthorised items, such as mobile
  phones, smartwatches, watches, airpods/earphones or notes, in the exam room. If they bring such
  items, they should be placed in the tray provided. Just having an unauthorised item, even in their school
  bag, can result in disqualification.
- Talking or Disruptive Behaviour: Any talking, attempts to communicate, or disruptive behaviour during the
  exam is prohibited. This includes making noises to gain attention, which may result in disqualification, as
  it disrupts the fairness of the exam.
- Leaving the Exam Room Without Permission: Students must remain in the exam room for the required time unless they are given permission by an invigilator. Leaving the room unsupervised is considered a breach of exam regulations.
- Misuse of Exam Papers or Materials: Writing inappropriate or offensive material, doodling on the exam paper, or attempting to remove any materials from the exam room can lead to disqualification.

### Career of the Week: (Career of the Week)

To become an architect, you'll need to complete: a degree recognised by the <u>Architects Registration Board</u> (ARB), a year of practical work experience, a further 2 years' full-time university course like BArch, Diploma, MArch, a year of practical training and a final qualifying exam



You'll need a portfolio when you are interviewed for degree courses. Course providers will want to see a portfolio that includes hand drawn sketches, photographs and models.

As an architect you will create hand sketches, 3D models and technical plans using computer aided design (CAD) software, create a plan that follows building laws, safety regulations and is within budget, manage construction projects, choose materials and visit sites to check on progress, write reports and job proposals and complete planning applications and communicate and share ideas with clients, other architects and architectural technologists and technicians
