Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Geography Human Fieldwork Residential 12 -13 May 2023

It gives me great pleasure to inform you about an exciting trip we are planning for **12 -13 May 2023** to the Olympic Park in Stratford London. This trip has been put in place to cover our mandatory fieldwork that is part of the GCSE specification. This will make up around 20% of their overall grade. We have therefore tried to offer a trip this year that will encompass exceptional fieldwork as well as enrichment opportunities.

The voluntary contribution for this trip is £135 (confirmed). We are providing a number of activities to ensure the experience is unforgettable, as well as having geographical enquiry at its heart. We have managed to secure all of this for a very reasonable price of £135.

The trip has now been set up on Parentpay. We ask that a deposit of £50 is paid by the 10th December 2022 and thereafter there are a further 4 instalments of £21.25 each.

We must tell you that, as the school could not bear any of the costs of the trip without reducing its ability to provide the books and materials that are essential for its curricular needs, the trip cannot take place unless all parents who are able to are willing to contribute. If you would like your son/daughter to participate, but are unable to contribute the full amount, please contact me in confidence, in writing, by 28 November 2022.

Should there be changes in government guidelines which results in a trip having to be cancelled as has happened previously during the pandemic, we are no longer able to claim on WSCC insurance for any loss. For this reason we are now only booking trips where the company providing the trip offers a robust cancellation/refund system in respect of Covid cancellations.

At the time of writing there are currently no Government Covid restrictions that may apply to this trip. However, as the Covid 19 situation may change, we will have to follow the Government guidance in place at the time of the trip. This may also include specific requirements that the venues and attractions that we will be visiting have in place.

Therefore it is necessary to point out that should your child be unwell at the time of the trip or is unable to take part in the trip due to Covid 19 restrictions that affects them, unfortunately you will not be able to receive a full refund for the place you have booked.

Your consent to your child attending this trip will be deemed to have been given by you logging into your Parent Pay account and paying for this trip, once you have been notified you have a space. You will also be asked for your contact details for the trip and any medical details that your child may have.

As this is a residential trip, we will require a medical consent form to be completed. This can be done via the google link <u>Medical consent form</u>

If you would prefer to have a paper copy of the form please let us know.

If your child withdraws from the trip at any time, you may not be entitled to a refund of instalment monies paid.
