#### New role for Mr Smith

## Potential for further strike disruption in July

This is a quick update to remind you that whilst there are no further confirmed strike days this term the major teaching unions are balloting their staff with a view to calling on them to strike again before the end of term. They have 'pencilled in' the week of 3rd to 7th July but there has been no confirmation of strike dates at the time of writing.

The ongoing dispute relates to the Department for Education's refusal to enter into talks on pay restoration, working conditions, depleted school funding and the recruitment crisis.

If strike dates are confirmed we will work with our local union representatives to try to establish the extent of their members' support and then plan accordingly.

On Tuesday 13th June, 8 Angmering School pupils competed in a chess tournament at Windlesham House School. The event is the largest of its kind in the UK with 128 players in total which included 15 county players and 3 England players. From the 19th June 2023 there will be traffic lights at the junction of Dappers Lane. This will enable Southern Water to complete the final stage of work safely without having to completely restrict access along Dappers Lane.

Traffic will still not be able to turn left out of the road towards the A280.


There will be a diversion in place. We have been provided with a map of the diversion from Southern Water
