12:40 - 13:20 lunch (there will be a warning bell at 13:15).

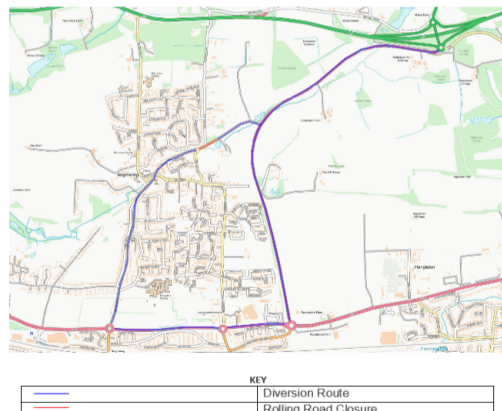
13:20 - 14:15 period 4
