### NEU Strike dates confirmed for 5th and 7th July

The National Education Union (NEU) has confirmed that they have now called on all of their members to strike on **5th July and 7th July**. This is as a response to the government's refusal to return to the negotiating table to talk about school funding, real terms pay cuts, working conditions and the recruitment crisis. The previous pay offer of 4.5% (with 4% expected to come from existing school budgets) was rejected by all education unions.

Owing to the large number of Angmering staff who are NEU members, together with the high levels of support for previous strikes, we are once again forced to move to **online schooling for both the 5th and 7th July**. Any teaching staff who are not joining the strike will run live lessons via Google Meet, for the remaining lessons students will be able to access subject specific learning resources from <u>BBC Bitesize</u> and <u>Oak National Academy</u>.

We completely understand the frustration of many parents/carers and students about the disruption to education which these strikes cause; this is not something which any staff member wants to have to do. As I have explained previously, both staff pay and school funding have reduced in real terms since 2010 and this is impacting on our ability to provide high quality education. Additionally, any pay settlement which is not funded by additional money to schools will simply reduce the resources and services available to your children in schools.

If you feel frustrated by the current situation we would encourage you to express this to your MP or to the Secretary of State for Education rather than focusing it on school staff who are fighting for fair funding for your child's education. Your support is greatly appreciated.

## **Year 6 Transition Day**

Owing to the strike action by the NEU we are having to run a reduced program for Year 6 children on the 5th July. We are continuing to provide some Transition Day activities as we think it is vital that children feel confident about coming to their new school in September. The activities will be supported by support staff, members of the Headship Team and external visitors. We are currently planning on running a program between 9:30 and 13:30 on 5th July. Further details will be sent out next week.



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### Uniform for the remainder of term

Although the temperatures are set to remain around 21 degrees next week we are increasingly aware of the high humidity which is making many of the rooms in school uncomfortable. We are therefore moving to 'no blazers' for the remainder of the term. Students may leave their blazers at home but should continue to wear the rest of their uniform as normal. Please remind your child to put their Standards Card and other school equipment into their bag rather than leaving any of it at home in their blazer next week!

### VIPs at the West Sussex SENDCO Conference!

Each year all of the SENDCOs from West Sussex schools hold a conference to share ideas and discuss strategies for supporting children who have additional needs. 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
### **Road Closure**

Water Lane will be closed between the junction of The David Wilson Estate and the junction of Weavers Hill. Small sections will be closed at a time to minimise impact to residents and Businesses. Work will start here on the 15th May 2023.

From the 19th June 2023 there will be traffic lights at the junction of Dappers Lane. This will enable Southern Water to complete the final stage of work safely without having to completely restrict access along Dappers Lane.

Traffic will still not be able to turn left out of the road towards the A280.


There will be a diversion in place. We have been provided with a map of the diversion from Southern Water
