I hope you have had a good week and students enjoyed the activity evening last Thursday. It was lovely to see so many attending and to meet so many parents who came for refreshments and a chat with staff.

Induction day is Wednesday 5th **July:** In order to make Induction Day as normal as possible, please arrange for your child to arrive at the School Canteen by 8.30am. You should collect them from there, or arrange for their safe journey home at 3.00pm. The front gate, by the field, will open at 8.10am to enable students only to go to the canteen. Parking or drop off will not be available on site (unless previously agreed by the Lavinia Norfolk Centre or the Head of Year), so please do walk if you can.

The Bramley Green Gate will be open from 8.10am. There will be guides to show you to the canteen. For coming home the gate will not open until 3pm but our guides will bring students who wish to leave this way to the gate at 3pm if you could wait for them there.

If your child requires medication during the school day this needs to be handed in to a member of staff on the front gate in a named bag. Please collect this from the same place at the end of the day.

We want our new students to enjoy their move to our school and this day is designed to be enjoyable and to calm any last worries or fears. During the day the new students will tour the school and take part in some lessons. The activities give students a first taste of life at their new school, help them make new friends and enable them to get to know the tutors who will be so important to them next year.

Students should wear their existing school uniform and bring with them a pencil case containing a pencil, pen and eraser. They will experience two taster lessons during the day. One will be a science lesson so please ensure long hair is tied back and no open toed shoes are worn. The other lesson will be Humanities.

At Angmering we have DEAR time – Drop Everything And Read. This happens every day for 20 minutes. Your child will need to bring a book with them to read on induction day. This should be a fiction story book.

Students will eat their lunch in school and they can either buy food in our canteen, operating as a self-service cafeteria which sells a wide range of food, or bring a packed lunch to eat there. They will be allowed into the cafeteria before the rest of the school. Students can purchase a main meal and a pudding for £2.50. The canteen will be serving pizza and potato wedges on induction day. Alternatively, students can purchase a sandwich meal deal which consists of a sandwich or baguette or a wrap with either cake or fruit and water or milk for £2.50. There is a maximum spend limit of £4.50. The canteen will take cash on induction day but please do remember that in September the canteen can only be used via money on parent pay which is why I remind you all to ensure you have logged onto your MCAS account to ensure you have given consent for the biometric fingerprints to be taken in September. Any parents who have not accessed this yet were sent a reminder yesterday.

We will make arrangements for those students who have free school meals to be provided with a meal on the day. There will not be access to the canteen during the morning break so students may bring a snack with them if they wish. We ask that students are given a bottle of water to bring with them. Please note we are a water only site and no squash or fizzy drinks should be brought to school.

We do have an evening for parents only on the 5th July starting at 6pm in the canteen. This will be an opportunity to speak with our uniform supplier and also to meet the tutors and ask any questions you may have.
