Upcoming Charity Events

On Friday 11th November the school community will mark the national day of remembrance. Staff and students are welcome to wear poppies, which will be for sale around school on behalf of the Royal British Legion, throughout next week. A small commemoration service will take place at the front of the school and we will ask staff and students to support the national two minute silence at 11:00 on Friday.



Children In Need Day will run on Friday 18th November and there will be a number of events running during the day in order to raise money for the charities. All students and staff are encouraged to donate £1 to 'Wear Something Spotty' along with their normal school uniform on this day. Due to exam regulations Y11 must be in uniform for exams but can add spotty additions after the exam is over.

Year 11 Mock Exams

Mock exams are an important part of our students' preparations for their final exams next summer. The first series of mock exams for Year 11 students will run from Monday 7th November to Friday 18th November. All students will be issued with a personal timetable for their mock exams. Normal lessons will continue to run; students will only be out of lessons to take their mock exams.

Benefit Related Free School Meals

A reminder that your child may be eligible for benefits related Free School Meals. HAF sessions provide children with access to fun and engaging activities during the holidays and offer a free meal as part of the sessions.
