## Arrangements for the NEU strike day on Thursday 2nd March

The second day of strike action by NEU members is scheduled for Thursday 2nd March and we have been working to plan our response. Whilst union members do not have to inform us of whether they intend to strike next week, we know from the previous strike day that support for the strike is likely to be **very high** among teaching staff and that the vast majority of our teachers are members of the NEU. For this reason we are opting to move to 'online school' for all students on Thursday 2nd March. Some teachers will be running live lessons via Google Meet on the strike day, if this is the case we will ask them to confirm this with their classes via email and messages on Google Classroom. We would encourage all students to check their email on the morning of the 2nd March and join all of the live lessons which are available to them. Where no live lesson is running we would like students to access resources from the following nationally approved platforms:
