Dear parents/carers and students,

High levels of staff absence

You may be aware from speaking with your children that we are currently experiencing high levels of staff absence, mainly due to colds, flu and stomach bugs. We are doing our best to manage this situation but we know that students will be affected by the absence of their normal teachers. We will continue to monitor the situation over the coming days and hope that we do not have to move to remote learning for selected year groups as we have been forced to do in recent years. As always the safety of students will be our primary concern.

End of term arrangements

There are three changes to the normal timetable and expectations during the last 2 days of this term:

- Thursday 15th December Christmas Lunch (Normal uniform plus optional Christmas jumpers.)
- Friday 16th December Year 11 Dress Up Morning (details below)
- Friday 16th December Early closure (students finish at 12:15). The Findon Bus will collect at 12.30pm and there will be a minibus to drop students to Ferring Library leaving from the **front** of school at 12.30pm.

Year 11 Dress Up

Angmering has long had a tradition of giving Year 11 students the option to wear fancy dress (provided it is suitable for school!) on the final day of the Autumn term. I suspect that the students will have some 'interesting' costumes again this year. In terms of rules we only ask that students:

- a. Can sit in a classroom and attend a lesson in their costume
- b. Can be identified (their faces are visible so no full body morph suits please)
- c. Remember that they are in a school environment...

Sixth Form sleep out in aid of charity

On the very cold night of 25th November a group of Angmering Sixth Form students took part in a sleep out in order to raise money for a local homelessness charity. The sleep out followed the group's NCS summer experience, where the then GCSE students created a lasting legacy with their Pebble For Your Thoughts project focusing on mental health, including a Beach Campaign Day in Littlehampton and designing a mural for the school to help other students in future. The event raised £400 and was covered by the local press and their report can be found here.

Uniform - affordability
