You can get into this job through:

- A University course
- A College course

Career Progression

With experience, you could:

- become a senior designer or creative director
- move into project or studio management
- go freelance or start your own design agency
- take up teaching or lecturing



UNIVERSITY

You could take a foundation degree, higher national diploma or degree in a design related

- graphic design
- art and design

Getting work experience during your course will give you an advantage when you start applying about work experience, internship and year placement opportunities, as well as any support offered to help you build a portfolio.

COLLEGE

You could take a college course in graphic design as a design assistant.

Day to day tasks

Day to day, you could:

- discuss the client's requirements and come up with creative ideas
- work out budgets and deadlines
- produce drafts and present your ideas on wording, images and layout
- prepare designs using specialist software
- review what you've done to make sure it meets the design brief
- make presentations to clients for feedback and approval
- keep up to date with design trends and developments in software tools

TERENCE DAVID JOHN PRATCHETT WAS AN ENGLISH AUTHOR, HUMORIST, AND SATIRIST, BEST KNOWN FOR THE DISCWORLD SERIES OF 41 COMIC FANTASY NOVELS PUBLISHED BETWEEN 1983 AND 2015.

AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH, PRATCHETT HAD SOLD MORE THAN 85 MILLION BOOKS WORLDWIDE IN 37 LANGUAGES. HE WAS ALSO THE UK'S BEST-SELLING AUTHOR OF THE 1990S.
