Electricians install power, lighting and renewable technologies in buildings. They also inspect and repair electrical control systems and machinery.

#### You can get into this job through:

- a College course
- an Apprenticeship

#### Apprenticeships

You can apply to do an apprenticeship with a company, such as:

- Installation and Maintenance Electrician Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship
- Domestic Electrician Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship

Apprenticeships are open to all ages. You can also train to become an electrician through an apprenticeship in the armed forces.

#### Career Progression

With experience, you could work in:

- site supervision
- estimating and contract management
- electrical project design
- training and assessment
- You might also become self-employed and set up your own electrical business.

#### Day to day tasks

As an electrician, you could:

- test electrical systems to make sure they're safe
- build electrical control panels
- service and repair electrical components in machinery
- fit smart controls for lighting, heating and security systems
- install electrical and fibre-optic cabling in homes and businesses
- respond to emergency call outs
