DID YOU KNOW?

Pancake day dates back to around 1000AD and marked the start of Lent. Everyone was expected to go to their confessor and confess any sins and this time was known as Shrovetide, hence the name Shrove Tuesday.

Historically, believers have abstained from rich foods including dairy and eggs during lent and therefore people liked to use up these foods before the 40 day fasting period.

The British custom of eating pancakes on Shrove Tuesday goes back to around the 16th Century!

Recipe



- 120g Plain White Flour
- 2 Large Eggs
- 300ml Milk

- Mix the flour, eggs and milk to form a batter. Ideally leave to stand for 30 minutes
- Grease a frying pan with butter lightly
- Spoon 2 tablespoon of batter in a heated pan for each pancake and swirl the pan so that the batter covers the pan
- Cook for around 1 minute each side

WORLD RECORD

The fastest flipper officially is Australian celebrity chef Brad Jolly. He holds the record for the most tosses of a pancake in one minute, notching up a so far unbeatable 140 flips in 60 seconds

Farmer



You can get into this job through:

- University
- College
- An apprenticeship

Day to day tasks

Day to day, you could:

- plan production and manage the business
- raise and manage livestock
- plant, grow and harvest crops
- manage budgets and negotiate with buyers and suppliers
- maintain farm equipment
- recruit, train and supervise farm staff
- make sure the farm follows health and safety regulations and biosecurity standards



UNIVERSITY

You could take a foundation degree, higher national diploma or degree in:

- agriculture
- land management
- farm business management
- crop and livestock production

COLLEGE

You could do a course at agricultural college to learn some of the skills you'll need to start your career in farming.

Courses include:

- agriculture
- land-based operations
- T Level in Agriculture, Land Management and Production

APPRENTICESHIP

You could apply to do an intermediate or advanced apprenticeship, for example:

- General Farm Worker Level 2
- Poultry Technician Level 3
- Livestock Unit Technician Level 3
- Crop Technician Level 3

Career Progression

With experience you could become a farm consultant, advising other farms in areas like new technology, developments in feed and fertilisers and diversification.

What it takes

You'll need:

- leadership skills
- to be flexible and open to change
- the ability to work well with others
- the ability to use, repair and maintain machines and tools
- the ability to work on your own
- excellent verbal communication skills
- patience and the ability to remain calm in stressful situations
- business management skills
- to be able to use a computer and the main software packages competently
