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Career of the Week - Aerospace Engineer

You could do a degree in aerospace engineering, avionics, or a subject like: electrical or electronic engineering, mechanical engineering, manufacturing or product engineering, physics or applied physics or software engineering or mathematics.

You could do a Level 6 Degree Apprenticeship to begin your career in the aerospace industry. Apprenticeships include: Aerospace Engineer, Aerospace Software Engineer, Electro-Mechanical Engineer or Materials Science Technologist

You'll combine workplace learning with study for a degree at university.

In this job, you'll:

- build and test prototypes using computer aided design (CAD) software
- analyse test results to improve aircraft structures and aerodynamics
- research new types of fuel and ways to reduce engine emissions
- manage projects and supervise a team of engineers and technicians
- develop new instruments and software for spacecraft
- plan and supervise maintenance programmes
