### Career of the Week:

To become a dentist you'll need to complete a 5-year degree in dentistry approved by the <u>General Dental Council</u>, followed by 1 to 2 years of postgraduate dental training. When you apply for a dentistry course, you could be asked to take the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT) or BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT).



You'll usually need: 3 A levels, or equivalent, including biology and chemistry to undertake a university course to progress into dentistry.

A Dentist will undertake these duties: lead a dental team to diagnose and treat dental problems, see patients for routine check ups, perform treatments like fillings, extractions and fitting dentures and bridges, take X-rays and give local anaesthetics.

"Dentists are the frontline of good oral health. They work with communities to prevent and treat dental/oral disease, correct dental irregularities and treat dental/facial injuries."


