Career of the Week : **Zoologist**

You can get into this job by doing a university course. You could study for a degree in a subject, such as: zoology, animal ecology and behaviour, conservation, marine biology or environmental biology

You may need a relevant postgraduate qualification like a master's degree or PhD for certain jobs, particularly in research.



As a zoologist, you could work in agriculture, conservation, pharmaceuticals or for government departments. You'll usually specialise in an area like: ecology - animal environments, herpetology - reptiles, entomology - insects, ornithology - birds, parasitology - parasites or paleozoology - fossil remains. Depending on your role, sector and specialism, you could: do field and laboratory research, study animals in their natural environment or in captivity, identify, record and monitor animal species, gather and interpret information and data or write detailed technical reports, give presentations and publish research findings in journals and books

Black History Month




Marcus Rashford
Manchester United Footballer

Rashford joined United at the age of seven. He scored on his England debut in May 2016, becoming the youngest English player to score in his first senior international match.

Rashford has been praised for using his platform to be a political activist and philanthropist to drive societal change. He is a campaigner against racism, homelessness and child hunger in the UK. He has been recognised for his efforts by organisations both within and outside of sport.

For the 2020 World Book Day, Rashford supported a campaign to help share a million stories. He also agreed to judge a poetry competition for children with hearing impairments, and began learning sign language in preparation.

He has teamed with Macmillan Publishers to launch a book club to help vulnerable and underprivileged children experience the "escapism of reading".



Claudette Colvin
Civil Rights Activist

Claudette Colvin (born Claudette Austin, September 5, 1939) is an American pioneer of the 1950s civil rights movement and retired nurse aide.

On March 2, 1955, she was arrested at the age of 15 in Montgomery, Alabama, for refusing to give up her seat to a white woman on a crowded, segregated bus. This occurred nine months before the more widely known incident in which Rosa Parks, helped spark the 1955 Montgomery Bus boycott.

For many years, Montgomery's black leaders did not publicize Colvin's pioneering effort. Colvin has said, "Young people think Rosa Parks just sat down on a bus and ended segregation, but that wasn't the case at all. Colvin's case was dropped by civil rights campaigners because Colvin was unmarried and pregnant during the proceedings. It is now widely accepted that Colvin was not accredited by civil rights campaigners at the time due to her circumstances."
