Career of the Week: COVGP SUDGRABSOP

To become a cover supervisor, having a minimum of a grade 4 in Maths and English is essential because these qualifications demonstrate a foundational level of literacy and numeracy. Proficiency in English is crucial for effectively communicating with students, understanding and conveying instructions, and assisting with coursework.



A cover supervisor in a secondary school plays a critical role in ensuring that students continue to receive quality education in the absence of their regular teachers. Their key responsibilities include supervising classes during teachers' absence, maintaining order, and engaging students in planned activities or assignments. They are also responsible for managing classroom behavior, ensuring that students remain focused on their tasks, and providing support as needed. Additionally, cover supervisors may be tasked with reporting any issues to the appropriate staff and helping to maintain a positive learning environment that fosters student engagement and respect.
