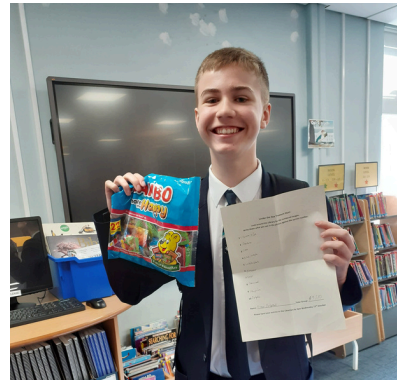

Bonfire Night Safety Tips



1. Never approach a lit firework, even if you think it isn't working.
2. Keep a safe distance from firework displays and bonfires.
3. Wear gloves when handling a sparkler, and hold it at arm's length.
4. Put used sparklers in a bucket of water once they go out.
5. Keep pets and animals inside.
6. Keep fireworks in a closed box; they should only be handled by adults.
7. Build a bonfire away from sheds, trees and fences.
8. Check there are no cables above the bonfire.
9. Never use flammable liquids on a bonfire, as these can be dangerous.
10. Make sure you have a large bucket of water to hand, in case of an emergency.

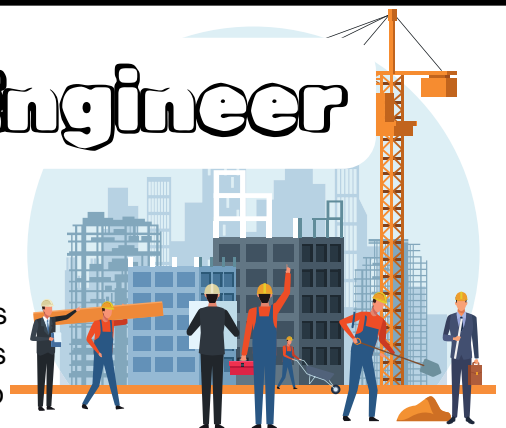

Career of the Week **Structural Engineer**

You can become a structural engineer through: a university course, a college course, an apprenticeship or working towards this role.

A Structural Engineer would undertake these duties : develop engineering plans using computer software, investigate the properties of building materials like glass, steel and concrete, work out the loads and stresses on different parts of a building , use computer models to predict how structures will react to the weather, work out ways to improve energy efficiency, inspect unsafe buildings and decide whether they should be demolished and work out why and how buildings have collapsed



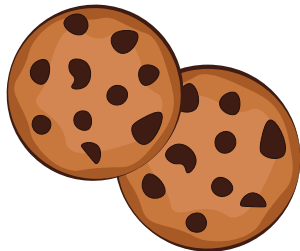
