Year 8 English Theatre Trip - Shakespeare's Globe, London

We are delighted to be able to offer our Year 8 English students a trip to Shakespeare's Globe in London on Tuesday 6 June to see a production of A Midsummer Night's Dream.

It will be a wonderful experience for students to see a live performance as audiences would have experienced in Shakespeare's time. This is also the text that we are studying in the summer term.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 10.45 am. We are still waiting for details of the running time of the performance but we anticipate that we will arrive back at Angmering School at around 7 - 7.30 pm.

Please note these are <u>standing</u> tickets directly in front of the stage and the roof of the Globe theatre is open.

The cost of the trip is £30 including ticket, return coach travel and parent pay fee.

Students should wear school uniform but may wear trainers. Depending on the weather forecast they may need to bring sunscreen and a cap.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them to eat on the coach.

We have 49 places available. If the trip is over subscribed, places will be allocated by ballot. You will be advised shortly after Monday 27 March if your child has a place and details will be put onto Parent Pay. Payment must be made by Friday 5 May 2023 as we have to pay for the tickets in advance.

Please do not try to pay until you have confirmation that your child has a place on the trip. A waiting list will be kept for students who do not gain a place.

Covid guidance:

Should there be changes in government guidelines which results in a trip having to be cancelled as has happened previously during the pandemic , we are no longer able to claim on WSCC

insurance for any loss. For this reason we are now only booking trips where the company providing the trip offers a robust cancellation/refund system in respect of Covid cancellations.

At the time of writing there are currently no Government Covid restrictions that may apply to this trip. However, as the Covid 19 situation may change, we will have to follow the Government guidance in place at the time of the trip. This may also include specific requirements that Worthing Museum has at that time.

Therefore it is necessary to point out that should your child be unwell at the time of the trip or is unable to take part in the trip due to Covid 19 restrictions that affects them, then unless we are able to find a student to take your child's place, you will not receive a refund for the place you have booked.

We must tell you that, as the school could not bear any of the costs of the trip without reducing its ability to provide the books and materials that are essential for its curricular needs, the trip cannot take place unless all parents who are able to are willing to contribute. If you would like your son/daughter to participate, but are unable to contribute the full amount, please contact me in confidence, in writing, by **Monday 27 March**.
