#### OfSted inspection - Tuesday 11th and Wednesday 12th October

As you will hopefully be aware we were subject to a 'Graded Inspection' by OfSted this week. These inspections, which were formerly called Section 5 inspections, are the only ones which allow a school's overall grade to be changed.

A team of 5 inspectors including 2 of 'His Majesty's Inspectors' (HMI) spent two days looking at all aspects of the school's work. We were extremely proud of the positive way which both staff and students responded to the team and we know that they felt very welcomed by all. Thank you to those of you who completed the parent/carer questionnaire either prior to or during the inspection, this was a useful part of their evidence base.

Governors and senior staff are aware of the outcome but this cannot be shared until the official report is published in around 4 weeks time. Once the report is published we will share it with all parents/carers. In the meantime it is back to 'business as usual'!
