'My Child At School (MCAS) App - your window into your child's school day

As many of you will already know we are now using BromCom in school to log every student's attendance, rewards and sanctions. If you have not already done so please ensure that you have the MCAS app installed on your phone/tablet/PC so that you can stay informed about how your child is doing in school. If you are not already set up and using the system please click here to visit the school website for further information and guidance.

We are now communicating all of the homework on the MCAS platform, this allows you to see what has been set for your child so that you can monitor their work at home. The completion of homework is tracked by the class teacher and they will add a 'C1' (consequence) to the MCAS system if any homework is not completed. Please do not worry if MCAS states that homework is 'not handed in' as we are not using the MCAS system to track completion. If your child does not receive a 'C1' sanction you can assume that they are completing their homework to the required standard.

If you have any feedback on the new system we would be grateful to receive it through the usual email channels. Many thanks for your support.

Have you considered becoming a Cover Supervisor?

We are currently looking for new Cover Supervisors to join our excellent team in school. The role of a Cover Supervisor is to organise and monitor the learning of students whose teacher is absent from work (normally due to illness or training). All of the work is provided by the teacher, along with any instructions for what the students should be completing and where any additional resources can be found. The Cover Supervisors uphold the same behaviour routines as teaching staff (lining students up for lessons, sitting them in designated seats, ensuring uniform is up to standard etc.) and can issue both rewards and sanctions as appropriate. No specialist subject knowledge is required and full training and induction are provided.


