Dear parents/carers and students,

Friday 4th October

Your children may have come home this term telling you that they are no longer allowed to put their hands up to answer questions in class..... This is not strictly true but we have moved to a system of 'No hands questioning' (or cold calling) in our lessons. This involves the teacher posing a difficult question to the whole class, giving them a short time to think (or perhaps discuss with a partner) and then selecting one student to respond. Other students may then be selected to add to the response or explain whether they agree or disagree. This method of questioning has been proven to deepen students' understanding and develop their thinking skills. Early observations suggest that it is working really well so we will continue to refine and develop this over the course of the year.

Walking, Talking Mocks (Year 11)

The English, maths and science teams have started to offer an excellent opportunity to Year 11 students after lessons. They are running 'Walk, Talking Mocks' in the main hall. This involves a teacher talking through an exam paper and provide model answers and associated notes. Students follow the teacher (with their own copy of the paper) and can leave with a fully completed 'perfect' paper, alongside their own comments. These are open to all Year 11 students and the schedule has been shared with them all (and can be seen below). Please encourage your children to attend. They are really powerful sessions.

My Child At School (MCAS) App - your window into your child's school day

As many of you will already know we are now using BromCom in school to log every student's attendance, rewards and sanctions. If you have not already done so please ensure that you have the MCAS app installed on your phone/tablet/PC so that you can stay informed about how your child is doing in school. If you are not already set up and using the system please click here to <u>visit the</u> <u>school website</u> for further information and guidance.

We are now communicating all of the homework on the MCAS platform, this allows you to see what has been set for your child so that you can monitor their work at home. The completion of homework is tracked by the class teacher and they will add a 'C1' (consequence) to the MCAS system if any homework is not completed. Please do not worry if MCAS states that homework is **'not handed in'** as we are not using the MCAS system to track completion. If your child does not receive a 'C1' sanction you can assume that they are completing their homework to the required standard.

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics
