March 8th 2023 5.30pm	<b>Parents Meeting for those students who have been allocated The Angmering School but who did not have the school as 1st choice.</b> Additional information will be sent directly to the families in this position.
March 2023	<b>Electronic admission forms will be sent to parents via email</b> We will be in touch shortly with an electronic admission form
March 2023	<b>Initial contact with feeder primary schools</b> This will initially be focused on any individual students who may need an enhanced transition programme
May 2023 Wed 3/5 3.30-5.30pm, Thurs 4/5 4-6pm, Tues 9 May 4-6pm and Mon 15/5 3.30-5.30pm	<b>Individual contact with families from key members of staff</b> These will take place either as a virtual meeting or as a face to face meeting with a member of the headship team or a specialist member of the student support staff. Information will be available before Easter holidays regarding booking a convenient time
May 2023 15/5 to 16/6	<b>Visits from key staff to primary schools</b> These will be arranged to ensure we meet every student
May and June 2023 Wed 17 <sup>th</sup> May and Thurs 8 <sup>th</sup> June. 5.30pm to 7.30pm	<b>Activity Evenings</b> These are an opportunity for new year 7 students to come up to the school, meet new friends and try a range of activities.

<b>July 5th 2023</b>	<b>Induction Day</b> We are looking forward to face to face events with students. Plus we will have an evening for parents to attend that evening from 6-8pm with an opportunity to meet the tutors and ask any questions you may have.
<b>Tuesday 5th September 2023</b>	<b>1st Day at The Angmering School for Year 7 students</b>
<b>Wednesday 6th September 2023</b>	<b>First day of timetabled lessons for all students</b>

In addition to these activities for all those moving up to Angmering, there will be additional opportunities for students who need enhanced transition including a 6 week workshop for parents relating to managing your child's fears and worries and 3 days of summer activity sessions.
