

## Moving up to Angmering Issue 6 - Friday 24th June

## **Online Learning - ClassCharts & Google Classroom**

Over the last few years, teachers have supported students in adapting and changing their learning patterns with many more resources now being based online. At The Angmering School, we were already using a google based email system and google classroom for our students (even before COVID) but the use of this has developed further with many home learning activities now online as we feel that this is a positive way to support students' ongoing learning. In order to support students with virtual transition activities, all students will be given their Angmering School google logins on transition day on Wednesday 6th July by their tutor. Parents will also be given login information for parent apps at the Parents evenings also on the 6th July at 6pm.

Once a student has logged in for the first time, they will be able to access the google classroom for their tutor group and will be encouraged to participate in various online transition activities over the summer. This will be an important part of them moving up to their new school.

It is very important to us that all students are able to access IT equipment when at home. If your child does not have access to a computer or tablet which would allow them to access the google suite easily, please get in touch with Miss Pegden, Year 7 team leader, who can discuss ways in which we can support you further. The information below gives an overview of the two key online learning resources that we use: classcharts and google classroom.



#### Website - www.classcharts.com

**App available** - student version and parent version on android and ios **Purpose** - All student homework, positive rewards (credits) and sanctions (debits) are logged on classcharts. As a student or parent, you can see when homework has been set and when it is due to be handed in, you will also be able to see information about why credits or debits have been issued by staff.

**How to log in** - Students will get their login code from their tutor. Parents will be given their login on the 6th July and will be emailed to anyone who is unable to attend.

**Where to get help** - Students should ask tutors in the first instance. Parents can request help through year team administrators.

App available - on android and ios

**Purpose** - In many subjects, homework is now uploaded and handed in through google classroom. This enables teachers to upload resources and for students to have online worksheets and quizzes that are submitted directly to the teacher in google doc format allowing them to complete work on a range of devices. The dashboard gives an overview of the work requiring completion.



**How to log in** - Students will need to use their Angmering School google login which is the same for their email and google drive. This will be given to students by their tutor.

**Where to get help** - Google have produced a lot of support materials which can be used in the first instance. <u>https://support.google.com/edu/classroom</u>.

### Lockers

Lockers will be available to Year 7 students in the first few days of term in September. You will need a padlock but to fit the lock you will need one with the following dimensions. Please note that a smaller shackle diameter of 6mm may not secure the locking mechanism.
