Induction day reminders : Wed 2nd July Full details were given last week in our weekly email and are on the <u>website</u> if you need fuller details.

Time: 8.30am to 3pm. Please park outside the school gates and walk in. The Bramley Green gate and the front gate will be open at 8.10am. The front gate, by the field, will open at 8.10am to enable students only to go to the canteen. Parents must leave at the gate. There will be ambassadors to walk students around to the front of school.
