March 2025	Y6 Transition Data Collection Form We ask you to complete this to ensure a smooth transition, ensuring we can communicate with you and support your child's needs. It will take you approximately 10 minutes to complete. In this you can request a phone call from our safeguarding team to discuss any concerns you may have. We would like some feedback on language preferences so have included questions on this. A language will be studied until the end of Year 9. This survey is purely to give us an idea of preference and does not guarantee this is the language which will be allocated in Y7.
May 2025	We will be in touch with a link to MCAS which is a platform which we use currently for information and academic reports throughout the school year. A separate email with instructions will be generated from MCAS which will be sent to your email address - after May half term.
May/June 2025	Visits from key staff to primary schools These will be arranged to ensure we meet every student
